WIDA Screener is a brief English language proficiency assessment given only to new students in grades preK–11 who do not have previous ACCESS scores. The screener helps educators quickly identify whether or not they are English language learners (ELLs).	September. (Must be complete within 30 days of start of school)	Student report cards, progress reports, and transcripts will <i>not</i> reflect student scores. Student scores will be shared with teachers by the ML Coordinator. Parents are notified if their student is eligible for EL services.
WIDA ACCESS	Grades K-11th ■ English Language Learners	Administered to English learners in order to measure progress toward meeting the WIDA English Language Development Standards adopted by Minnesota.	February-March	Student reports will be sent home by the DAC. Student report cards, progress reports, and transcripts will <i>not</i> reflect student scores.

Fastbridge Progress Monitoring	Students identified as "high risk" in reading, math, or behavior and are receiving interventions.
